

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### LA VENARIA REALE

La Venaria Reale is a "permanent cultural project" that offers a wealth of opportunities to learn, to feel new emotions and to make new experiences, aimed at embodying the combination of "culture and social well-being", also mentioned among the goals of the 2030 Agenda adopted by all United Nations.

La Venaria Reale is a grandiose estate situated just outside of Turin. It includes the 80,000-square-meter surface of the monumental Reggia or palace, and 60 hectares of Gardens. The estate opens onto the 17th-century historical center of the town of Venaria and borders on the 3,000-hectare Park of La Mandria, with the homonymous Castle. It is an architectural and natural masterpiece of universal Baroque that was enlisted as a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1997. It reopened in 2007 when Europe's largest restoration project ever undertaken for the cultural heritage was completed. Its enhancement aims at involving the promotion and utilization of the entire Circuit of Royal Savoy Residences of Piedmont.











### THE RESTORATION PROJECT

The Reggia opened to the public on 12 October 2007, after 8 years of restoration work that followed 2 centuries of abandonment and neglect.

The restoration project, promoted by the European Union and curated by Ministry for the Cultural heritage and the Regional Government, required funding for **200 million euros**. It is regarded as **the largest project ever undertaken in Europe** for the recovery of the cultural heritage.













## **CULTURAL PRODUCTION**

The magnificent Reggia and Gardens of Venaria provide permanent displays, art and history exhibitions, and almost every day a wide range of activities takes place, including educational activities, conferences, didactic workshops, cultural and leisure events.

### FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT AND JOB CREATION

The Consortium, in charge of managing the estate ("The Reggia, Gardens and Castle of La Mandria"), has a permanent staff of 52, in addition to the Director (who has a fixed-term contract), 1 employee seconded by the Ministry and 14 seasonal employees. The total number of workers reaches about 200 when counting also external collaborators and employees of contractors and cooperatives providing outsourced services.

It is worth mentioning the **indirect employment** generated by linked activities in the tertiary sector for the surrounding area and beyond.







The Consortium's **annual budget** for activities, exhibitions, services, ordinary maintenance, HR, utilities, communication and promotions, etc. is generally around **13,5 million euros**.

Approximately 35% of the budget comes from the Consortium's Public Members, 27% from private members, and the remaining 38% consists of revenue from the estate's own activities, particularly proceeds generated by admission tickets, services to the public, location rental, royalties, sponsorships, management of cafés and restaurants and the bookshop, external activities and services etc..

**According to the Consortium's Memorandum of Association** (signed on 30 June 2008 and amended on 19 May 2014 and on 19 July 2017), **annual financial contributions** are broken down as follows:

Ministry of Culture: Variable contribution to support the Consor-

tium's activities

Regione Piemonte: 3.000.000 €

Town of Venaria Reale: 50.000 €

Fondazione Compagnia di San Paolo: 2.000.000 €

Fondazione 1563 per l'Arte e la Cultura: 1.000.000 €







### THE RESIDENZE REALI SABAUDE CONSORTIUM

La Venaria Reale is managed by the **Consorzio delle Residenze Reali Sabaude**—previously Consorzio di Valorizzazione Culturale La Venaria Reale (Consortium for the Cultural Promotion of the estate) -, made up of the following Members of the **Assembly of Associates**:

- Ministry of Culture
- Regione Piemonte
- Town of Venaria Reale
- Fondazione Compagnia di San Paolo
- Fondazione 1563 per l'Arte e la Cultura

The **Chairman** is appointed by the Assembly of Associates and proposed by the President of Regione Piemonte (in agreement with the Ministry).

The **Director** is appointed by the Board of Directors and proposed by the Ministry (in agreement with the President of Regione Piemonte).

The members of the **Board of Directors** are appointed by: the Ministry of Culture, Regione Piemonte, Città di Venaria Reale, Fondazione Compagnia di San Paolo and Fondazione 1563 per l'Arte e la Cultura.

The **Board of Auditors** is appointed by the Assembly of Associates as follows:

- President: designated by the Ministry
- two other members: one designated by Regione Piemonte, the other by Fondazione Compagnia di San Paolo.
