Frames by Davide Ferrario - Hall of Diana

In the Hall of Diana, cornerstone of 17th-century perspectives, the installation by Davide Ferrario with the artistic collaboration of Cristina Sardo, the music by Fabio Barovero, in collaboration with the National Museum of Cinema of Turin. The idea of *Frames* begins from the possibility to overlap the still images of the paintings with the light of films coming from the marvellous collection of the National Museum of Cinema of Turin, made between 1912 and 1954.

Anthony McCall. Solid Light - Citroniera

By Gregor Muir (Director of Collection at Tate modern - Exhibition Curator) and Andrew de Brún (Assistant Curator of International Art at Tate modern - Exhibition Co-Curator). In partnership with Tate, UK. The Juvarrà Citroniera hosts this exhibition-event, with some of the most significant installations by British artist Anthony McCall based on the relationship with light that directly involve the visitor in experiences that expand and exceed the traditional performances of artistic cinema.

Assembly by Marinella Senatore - Cascina

The large light-based installation *Assembly* (Assemblea) is inspired by the traditional luminaries of southern Italy, which the artist, through forms, texts and colour, makes spaces for meeting and reflection on self-awareness, one's own potential and action. The work evokes the Baroque festivities with their dramatic ephemeral apparatus and updates them by placing the community and the transformative power of art and participation at the centre. The great luminous sculptures, in the artist's practice, are the object of reflection on the western heterodoxy of the monument, as a symbol of white and male power, transformed into "monuments to people, here and now".
